The 2010 Cabernet Sauvignon Aiken Oakville has the potential to be a show-stopper. Its dense purple color is accompanied by sweet black currant fruit, licorice, graphite and floral notes. Complex aromatically, it hits the palate with resounding power, medium to full body and a long, juicy finish. This sexy, open-knit Cabernet is drinkable now, and capable of lasting a decade or more.

**2012 Aiken Wines Cabernet

More floral, with jammy black cherries and black currants is the 2012 Cabernet Sauvignon Aiken Rutherford. While it may be as good as the Oakville cuvee, the fruit expression is totally different. The wine possesses lots of glycerin, a full-bodied opulence and, like its siblings, is irresistible. It should drink well young and keep for 18-20 years.
